Akbar has reported all the tweets that he is aware of already. On some Twitter has responded saying the user's account has been disabled, on others it has responded by saying they don't detect anything but provide some security guidelines to follow.

I will do the same on all the tweets in which I am directly mentioned and/or that I am aware of, but what's tricky is that we are not seeing all the tweets about us because they will not always mention us.

We need a remedy beyond this reporting, but again, I will report all the harassing tweets directed to/about me, and Akbar has already done this for all of those which he is aware.




